Myself, Ravinder Birdie, Principal of the School, today I take immense pleasure to unfold the Journey of SMPPS on the eve of “**Silver Jubilee Foundation Day Function 2023**”.

The seed was sown in the year the 1998 on 28th October by the great visionary and spiritual leader **Shri 1008 Nirmal Narayan Maharaj ji**. The Foundation stone of Shri Mahaprabhu Public School was laid by her auspicious hands with the noble mission to cater quality education to the middle class children in English Medium with CBSE Board to help children nurture into fruitful and useful citizens of future India.

In the initial stages it was named as S.N.A. English Medium School under the guidance of dynamic and exuberant Leader Miss Mohan Sapru and Yog Guru Late Mahesh Chandra ji.

In 2005 under the guidance of Shri Shreebhagwan Pandey ji and blessings of all, Guruji I started my journey as founder Principal of Shri Mahaprabhu Public School with 65 students which grew to 2200 students in years come to promise and commitment.

The SMPPS Vision is to provide value based learning environment and seek to engage young mind to unlock their potential, enhance their competencies and skills. The school strive to foster every child in best of his mental health, personal excellence within a collaborative culture. The students are given different platforms to discover, and explore their imagination and opportunities.

The mission of Shri Mahaprabhu Public School is to provide quality, inter disciplinary, conceptual and scientific approach in understanding curriculum, our rich Culture, Heritage in the form of blended learning to develop Empowerment, self realization and responsible Citizenship in students.

REGARDING ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

The students of Shri Mahaprabhu public school not only achieved 100/100 marks in many subjects (Computer, Physical Education, Economics but also performing in Medical, Engineering, C.A., Law and various other fields.

Our first batch of class X appeared in 2008, Anshu Kumar Singh was the first topper. Leading to present 2023 batch with two toppers Sangam Singh & Utkarsh Shukla showing that the spirit to be at top is getting brighter day by day. Our class XII first batch appeared in 2010, first position was bagged by Pratishtha Narayan with 86.2% motivating others, the present position goes to Anuj Pandey with 96.4%. The graph is increasing year by year which shows the efficiency, efforts, dedication and commitment of the mentors and students. Parents are also great support in the progress of Shri Mahaprabhu Public School.

We are the first in the district offering NCC as an optional subject. As per New Education Policy and demand of development of social skill, subjects of social skill are given importance in the curriculum. Shri Mahaprabhu Public School is offering Information Technology, Food Production and Health Care as skill subjects to students to have good scope in the Higher Education.

Shri Mahaprabhu Public School started a campaign of “**Kare Yog Rahe Nirog**” to strengthen Physical and mental Health. The school also hold **THREE STAR FIT INDIA** status.

We are the record holder of "**Guinness World Record**" for the **largest science experiment** by our children in 2019.

We are the record holder of “**Golden Book of world record**” for the ‘**most people performing informal science experiment involving water (single location)**’ India.

We are the **Guinness Book holder** of the “**Biggest virtual poetry recitation event in India**” 2021.

We are the **Eat Right School Holder** from department of “**Food Safety and Standards Authority of India**” 2023.

We have successfully organised three sessions for “**BOSCH**” **skill training programme** and helped unprivileged students to get better livelihood.

The school is committed to help the students and support school dropout through “**NIOS**” with the saying “**Charity begins from home**”.

IN RELATION TO INFRASTRUCTURE

Shri Mahaprabhu Public School has a Huge Library of 100 seating capacity with many gazettes, Story books, Magazines, Digital Books and audio visual facility to cater each age group students with qualified and dynamic Librarian.

School has well equipped chemistry Lab, Physic Lab, Bio Lab, Composite Lab, Maths Lab, Health Care Lab, Food Production Lab etc.

School has two Computer Labs with the capacity of 150 computers and internet facility to have online examination for students.

The school is running student app, teacher App and various digital platforms to compete with the technology and smooth functioning.

The school has facility of online fees payment.

SMPPS IS KNOWN FOR INNOVATIVE PRACTICES

To promote students to learn different languages, class rooms name is given with Tamil Counting and section are named on our famous Gem stones (Pukhraj, Panna, Rubby, Munga, Neelam) and floors in the name of big trees (Neem, Mango, Banyan, Tamrind, Peepal and Prangans are named as Ganga, Jamuna, Nirmal & Girdhar.

To know the self emotions and for their mental health and well being students are asked to put Emoji's of different colours (**Emoji Lago Bhav Dikhao**) **Green = Happy, Blue = Tired and Hurt, Yellow = Sad, Red = Angry.**

These Emoji's help students to distinguish different moods and feelings and to seek assistance to handle and come out of the situation.

In the Assembly school students are in practice of saying ten positive affirmations daily to generate positive vibrations and confidence in them. Every Tuesday they recite (**Hanuman Chalisa**) and every Thursday they visit Samadhi Sthal of Gurudev and do Prayer. All these activities make them spiritually connected and promote self discipline.

Not only Students, Teachers, Office staff and utility staff after day over do the prayer, say ten positive affirmations and clap for 108 times, which promote feeling of gratitude, brotherhood, and team work.

NEXT COMES CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

To promote the competitive spirit and to bring out the talent of the students, they are encouraged to participate in various co-curricular activities. Competitions like Calligraphy, Drawing and Painting, Essay writing, singing, Recitation, Elocution, Dance, Fancy dress, Dramatics, Diya Painting, Rangoli etc. were conducted during the course of the year. All records have been put in the Annual magazine "**Inspiration**" to show case achievements and e-magazine is available on our school web site www.smpps.co.in.

There are 17 different clubs working on various aspects of social and academic importance of student's life ensuring its cultural, social and emotional integration with their educational needs.

Vishnu Priya got the National Level Bonze prize in Rifle shooting, Priyanka Tripathi got gold medal at national level CBSE in Judo Karate, Khushi Pandey got gold medal in Gymnastic.

SEMINARS AND CAMPS IS A PART OF CURRICULLAM

- On the occasion of traffic month, ADGP released a traffic song sung and composed by school teacher Mrs. Renu Raj Singh for public awareness of traffic rules and this song was released in public interest on the occasion of traffic month.
- Under the Disaster Management programme, the children were demonstrated by the fire brigade and told about the possible protections in case of fire and how to extinguish it.
- Carrier Counselling sessions and personal care and Hygiene camps. i.e. Dental Check-up, Eye Check-up, immunisation are organised for the benefits of the students.
- School is active part of social campaigns i.e. **“Beti Bacho and Beti Padhao”**, **“Good Touch Bad Touch”**, **“Cyber Crime”**, **“Puneet Sagar Abhiyan”**, **“Say No to Plastic”**, **Anti Tobacco Campaign**, **“Say No to Drugs”**, **“Namami Gange”** projects are some of the **“down the list”**.

AS A SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

- a. Students of Shri Mahaprabhu Public School every year distributes old clothes collected by them to the needy and poor in the slums of Teliyarganj, Prayagraj.
- b. Apart from this, I would also like to tell that before the pandemic years, food bank was being run by our school. Under which the food items collected by the school children were distributed among the needy and poor people. However after covid we had to stop this service. I hope we will be starting it again very soon.
- c. Depletion of nature and natural resources is the prime concern of this century. And our school has been playing crucial role in rebuilding the nature through various social awareness campaigns and taking initiative to adopt conservation practices. We are the part of Hon'ble Yogi ji's program "**Vriksha Mahakumbh Mahotsav**", the students of the school planted 3300 saplings.
- d. On Rakshabandhan, the festival of brotherly love, girl students send Rakhis to the Indian soldiers posted at the border.

CELEBRATIONS:

Our school enthusiastically celebrated “**Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav**”. It was a 7 days long celebration in which the students of various classes showed their respect towards the nation through Songs, Dance, Plays, Speeches etc. Tricolor was provided to all the children by school, for hoisting them at their homes under the nationwide campaign "**Har Ghar Tiranga**" and to encourage the common people.

We also celebrate various festivals and national and international days of social importance.

INVESTITURE CEREMONY

Every year school's student council elected and these students work to resolve the issues of the students and learn the Leadership.

EXCURSIONS

Excursions allow the kids to have new experiences and observe new things that are not available at school. Excursions are a learning tool to enhance the curriculum by allowing students to better grasp and retain concepts.

On October 2, the students of class 8 to 10 of our School took part in 'Heritage Learning Tour' under the aegis of Indian National Trust for Art and Cultural Heritage. Under this, visited various historical and religious places of Prayagraj. Through the excursion, the aim was to awaken the interest of the students towards their historical heritage and religious places.

Besides it, our students got opportunity to visit a number of research institutes (HRI) and colleges (United college and Motilal Nehru medical college).

TEACHER ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMS

We believe in equipping teachers to prepare the students for the future and to update their knowledge. So the school has successfully organized a 15 days teacher orientation program extending for more than 50 hours in 2022 and it's a regular practices till date.

Regular staff meetings are conducted to evaluate our quality of performance and plan for the future with more innovative methods of teaching and learning programs.
